The profession in Belgium

Any architect who wishes to practice the profession in Belgium must first register with the Order of Architects in Belgium.

Before registration is possible, you need to perform a two-year internship as practical continuation of your academic training.

When you complete your practical training you receive a practical training certificate. This document proves that you have satisfied the compulsory practical experience requirements and allows you to apply for entry to the roll.

Practical training

The internship is the practical continuation of your academic training. It is a two-year learning trajectory in which your theoretical knowledge is extensively tested against the practice of renovating and building for at least 120 hours per month.

Competences and skills that you have acquired during your studies are further honed and made concrete during the internship.

Under the guidance of an internship supervisor, you will become acquainted with the different facets of the profession.

Practical training in another country

Trainee architects may gain some or all of their practical experience in a foreign country. They must ask the Order of Architects for permission to do so in advance.

Students who are already entered on a trainee list must apply to the Council of the Order with which they are registered.

If they are not yet on a trainee list they must apply to the Council of the Order in their province of residence.

Scholarship programmes

Erasmus+ grants via Students on the Move programme:

- Recent graduates may apply for this scholarship. The traineeship must be completed within one year (12 months) of graduation.
- To participate in the Erasmus+ programme, students
 must register before graduation, i.e. before the date that your
 scores are officially announced. Registration is not possible
 after graduation.

Erasmus grants

Scholarships are awarded on a *first-come*, *first-served* basis until the budget is exhausted. Only complete applications will be considered: registration before graduation, signed Learning Agreement, uploaded diploma/degree certificate.

Group 1: Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Iceland, Finland, Luxembourg, Ireland, Liechtenstein, Faroe Islands, Switzerland, United Kingdom €529/€779

Group 2: Netherlands, France, Germany, Austria, Italy, Spain, Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, Malta, Andorra, Monaco, San Marino, Vatican City €479/€729

Group 3: Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, Bulgaria, Romania, North Macedocia, Slovenia, Croatia, Turkey, Serbia €429/679

Group 4: Countries not associated to the Erasmus programme €700/€950
